- Conduct periodical and ongoing systematic audits to identify and eliminate and/or control those conditions or work practices potentially harmful to the environment;
- Review environmental practices and procedures semi-annually to ensure information is up to date with the latest legislative and best practice requirements;
- Produce statistical reports and review environmental performance on projects on a semiannual basis, identify key areas for improvement based on performance and feedback and improve processes to achieve the highest standard possible;
- Implement reviews findings for practice to ensure environmental standards are maintained at industry highest.
